Note:

The Students who are already applied and not appeared to the PG CET examination for the first time need not apply and they can appear directly to PG CET Examination. The hard copy of the application and all necessary documents should reach to the Chairperson of the respective Department of Raichur University through Speed post or by hand within due date (the courier services not available to Raichur University, Raichur).

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS

a) Eligibility for Admission to the Post-Graduate Degree Courses

- i) Eligibility criteria for seeking admission to all the PG courses, in general, shall be a pass in the qualifying degree examination with a minimum of 45% in aggregate (40% for SC/ST/Cat-I candidates).
- ii) Entrance Test will be conducted for all courses. Admission shall be made on the basis of the merit list prepared by taking into consideration 50% of the aggregate marks obtained in the relevant subject(s) at qualifying Degree Examination (Aggregate of all three years) and 50% of marks obtained in the Entrance Test. Entrance Test consists of 50 multiple choice questions (MCQ) each carrying 2 marks a total of 100 marks. Duration of the Test will be 60 minutes.

1). MASTER'S DEGREE IN ARTS:

Minimum eligibility for seeking admission to all the PG courses in Arts Faculty shall be 45% (40% in case of SC/ST/Cat-I/PH) in the aggregate of all the subjects/papers and also in the subject in which admission is sought.

Minimum eligibility criteria for seeking admission to all the PG courses in Social Sciences Faculty shall be 45% (40% in case of SC/ST/Cat-I/PH) in the aggregate of all the subjects/papers, and also in the subject in which admission is sought.

Minimum eligibility criteria for seeking admission to all the PG courses in Science & Technology Faculty shall be 45% (40% in case of SC/ST/Cat-I/PH) in the aggregate of all the subjects/papers and also in the subject in which admission is sought.

Application Forms and Fees:

1. Candidates may apply for the concerned course online through UUCMS website (<https://uucms.karnataka.gov.in/Login/Index>) portal. The duly filled-in application form, along with all enclosures shall be submitted to the **Chairman, of respective Post Graduate Department, Admission Raichur University, Yergera, 584133 Raichur-** on or before **09 December 2024**. The application may also be sent through speed post only (courier services are not available to the campus) within the due date.
2. Candidates who desire to apply for more than one Department/course shall submit the application forms **separately to the concerned Department. Application Processing fee and Entrance test fees shall be paid online for each course for which the candidate desires to apply.**
3. The fees details are as under:
PG Courses Application processing and Entrance Test fees:
 - i. **General Merit: Rs.800/-**
 - ii. **SC/ST/Cat-I/PH/Trans Gender: Rs.400/-**
separately for each course applied;

Admission Note:

1. For the details of total intake under Normal Fees and Enhanced fees and Entrance Exam schedule for different courses in PG Departments and Affiliated Colleges. please visit our university website <http://raichuruniversity.ac.in>.
2. **Candidates whose results are awaited or candidates appearing for final year degree exams may also apply however, they must produce the necessary certificates/marks cards on or before 09.12.2024.**
3. All admission are purely based on Merit-Cum – Reservation.
4. Entrance test is mandatory for all admission to PG courses (including the management quota).
5. For all PG course minimum 10 students should get admitted to run the course. If the number of students are inadequate the course will not run and fee will be refunded.
6. Before submission of application candidate has to make sure that all the require subjects are filled for payment in UUCMS.

SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FORMS

The candidate after filling online application should take the print out of the same and has to submit the hard copy along with marks cards and certificates to the **Chairman, of respective Post Graduate Departments, Raichur University, Yeragera- 584133 Raichur** immediately. The candidate need not wait up to the last date.

CASTE/INCOME CERTIFICATE/FEES EXEMPTION

Candidates claiming reservation shall submit valid copies of the Caste/Income certificates/371(J), wherever applicable, issued by the Tahsildar/ Assisant commissioner.

Applications without valid certificates and inadequate information will not be considered.

Candidates from other Universities*, if selected, shall submit the *Eligibility Certificate* issued by the Academic Section, Raichur University, Raichur.

ALLOCATION OF SEATS

Admissions will be made as per the Government orders issued from time to time relating to reservation of seats. Allotment of seats to other University candidates will be as per the existing Rules of the University.

Note: The students who have admitted to various PG Courses at GFGCs, should report to the respective Principals on or before **09.12.2024**, otherwise their seats will be cancelled and those seats will be considered as vacant seat.

Intake and Allocation of Seats in main campus of Raichur University, Raichur

The intake capacity and allocation of seats for the students for admission to the Post-Graduate/Courses under Normal fees structure and Enhanced fees structure for the year 2024-25 are scheduled as follows:

Admission will be made as per the latest Government orders relating to reservation of seats. Selection of candidates from the other University will be as per the prevailing Rules of the University.

CLASSIFICATION FOR ALLOTMENT OF SEATS:

1) Reservation of seats for admission (under both the normal fee's structure and the enhanced fee's structure) to the various P.G. Courses and other courses shall be made as per the Roster/Existing Govt. Orders and also the provisions of the KSU Act-2000 relating thereto. As things stand today, the reservation of seats shall be done as follows:

- i. General Merit - 44%
- ii. Scheduled Caste - 17%
- iii. Scheduled Tribe - 07%
- iv. Category-I - 04%
- v. Category-II A - 15%
- vi. Category-II B - 04%
- vii. Category-III A - 04%
- viii. Category-III B - 05%

2. Two seats shall be reserved for the candidates from other Universities. □

- a) These two seats shall be within the INTAKE capacity under the Enhanced Fees structure.
- b) Of these two seats, one seat shall be reserved for the candidates from Sister Universities in Karnataka State and another for the candidate from the other Indian Universities.
- c) If there are no applicants for the seat reserved for the candidates from the sister Universities (or other Indian Universities), such vacant seat shall be filled in by selecting the eligible candidate from other Indian Universities (or the sister Universities) as the case may be.
- d) If both the seats remain vacant due to non-availability of applicants from both sister and other Indian Universities, such seats shall be filled-in by selecting the eligible candidates from Raichur University in the order of merit-cum-roaster under the enhanced fee's structure only.
- e) If some of the seats in any P.G. Departments remain vacant after duly admitting the candidates of Raichur University or any other sister Universities in Karnataka, as per



the existing guidelines for P.G Admissions, such seats shall be filled in by selecting the candidates of Indian Universities outside the Karnataka State as per the admission guidelines and existing Roster System under Enhanced fee's structure only.

3.

a) Two seats shall be reserved for the following groups:

1. Candidate who have shown distinction in sports/NCC/NSS for (one seat)
2. Ex-Serviceman/Children and wards of Defense personnel and Political suffers (one seat)

To qualify under each of the above category the following conditions shall be fulfilled:

- i) Sports Category: Candidate should be a University Blue or should have represented the State at any National level games.
- ii) NCC Category: Candidate should have 'C' Certificate or should have participated in Republic Day parade.
- iii) NSS Category: Candidate should have attended National level Camps.

All such candidates who qualify in each of the category as above are pooled together into one group. Seats will be allotted to candidates from this pool on the basis of overall merit (Entrance Test marks and performance in graduate course).

Allotment of candidates will be subject to a maximum of only one seat in any of the above category.

b) **Up to 5% of the TOTAL INTAKE capacity subject to minimum of one seat shall be reserved for differently abled persons under normal fees structure.**

c) These seats under 3 (a) and 3 (b) above shall be first deducted from the TOTAL INTAKE capacity of the respective course and the remaining seats shall subject to reservation/roster system.

d) In case if there are no candidates under either 3(a) or 3(b) or both, such seats shall be retransferred to the total intake before applying the Roster.

4)

a. The foreign nationals, including Persons of Indian Origin (PIO) and NRI 's if any, (up to a maximum of 15% of the total intake capacity) shall be admitted by creating the supernumerary seats subject to the fulfillment of the admission eligibility conditions.

b. Pay double the Enhanced Fees.

5) The candidates under the enhanced fee's structure shall be admitted only after completing the admission process under the normal fees structure.

6) The provisional selection list prepared and approved by the Departmental Council in its meeting and duly signed by the Chairman of the Department and the senior-most teacher of the Department shall be finally approved by the Dean of the concerned Faculty, before it is notified.



- 7) Up to 1% of the total intake in each department shall be reserved for Transgender category.
- 8) Children of HIV affected parents shall be entitled for free admission (except the entrance fee)subject to qualifying for admission.
- 9) Students who have been orphaned due to COVID-19 will be given free seats subject the production of Medical and death certificate of the parents.
- 10) Implementation of 371 (J) Reservation to Hyderabad- Karnataka Region students inthe admissions to all the course at Raichur University is as below:**
 - Reservation of 70% seats of the total intake (Normal and Enhanced) of all courses to the students of Hyderabad Karnataka Region and 30 % reservation for entire Karnataka Region.
 - The Normal fee seats shall be filled under the Normal fee structure and Enhanced fee seats shall be filled under the Enhanced fee structure.
